

A few ideas

If you want to share information

Text * Video * Podcasts * Readings (blogs, articles, book chapters) * Images * Stories * Case Studies * Interviews

If you want to provide practice/reinforcement

Case study with discussion questions * Practice exercises or assignments * Quizzes * Simulations * Games * Part-task practice (giving learners an example with some details, but with other parts of the problem they need to solve on their own)

Other approaches for teaching/reinforcing

Visual aids * Graphic organizers * Images with hot spots (users can click on an area to get more information) * Branched scenarios (like choose-your-own-adventure) * Evaluation activities (participants watch or read something and provide an assessment or commentary on it) * Summarizing (participants sign up for a reading and provide a summary for their peers) * Template and examples * Journaling * Concept maps

And a few more ideas!

Narrated screencasts (great for converting powerpoints to online content, or showing how to do something) * Cartoons or comics (such as Toon-Do) * Animated video (such as PowToon) * Flash cards * Polls (ask participants for feedback on content-related questions) * WIKIs (have participants created a course Wikipedia and build knowledge community together) * RSS feeds * Micro-learning (including using social media such as Twitter) * Role playing
